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## What is Political Culture?

"The political culture of a nation is the particular distribution of orientations towards

political objects" (Almond & Verba 1963)

- - -

political participation, involvement, trust in/ satisfaction with political system, efficacy

## What do we compare?

- Different settings of political culture: political histories and national institutions
- Different cohort structures
  ,political generations'
- Different cultures of aging

What does demographic change mean for Political Cultures?

- Changing political importance of different political generations
- Increase of effects associated with later phases of the life course

### **Research Question**

- Which effects are influential on the political attitudes and behavior?
- Do these effects differ in different countries?

Focus on negative effects of the later phases the in life course

# Design & Data Base

Subset of western European Countries:

- Similiar cohort socialisation
- Stable democracies with long time multiparty systems

Austria, Belgium, Germany, France & Netherlands

### Main Questionnaire

Political interest, efficacy, trust, electoral and other forms of participation, party allegiance, socio-political orientations, subjective well being, social exclusion, religion, discrimination, national/ethnic Identity,Values

# **Basic Comparison**

- Univariate: high similarities in distributions
- Bivariate on cohorts:

Chi Square based analysis of residuals in cells

- Mainly similar patterns
- Distinct similarities between cohorts overall especially in the oldest cohort

- Effects differ in countries, which can be interpreted as context effects

# Variables analyzed

Political Attitudes and Behavior: (Internal) Political Efficacy, Political Action Trust in national political institutions Aging related Social contacts, Activities, Beeing hampered & bad subjective health, Gender, Having a Partner
