**Doctoral student in the social aspects of AI (4 years, full-time)**

We have a vacancy for doctoral researcher (4 years full-time) studying the social aspects of AI.

Research related to labour markets, ageing, the life-course, or social policy is particularly appreciated. Examples of possible topics are: (a) generational differences in attitudes towards AI, (b) AI and older workers, (c) life-course influences within the technology acceptance model of AI, and (d) needs for labour market policy reforms due to the introduction of AI. The exact topic will be decided together with the successful candidate. Quantitative and qualitative methods are welcome.

The position is located within the working group of Prof. Kathrin Komp-Leukkunen at LUT University, Finland. Komp-Leukkunen leads the research group on social sustainability and welfare policies (<https://www.lut.fi/en/profiles/kathrin-komp-leukkunen>). This group is part of the Department of Social Sciences. It specializes in research on current developments within the labour market, such as digitalization and the green transition. LUT University is located in Lappeenranta, Finland.
